Administrative Procedure: #2017-001

Overview

To provide for the proper operation of the Pine Hill fire Department. Written reference materials and manuals are essential. The ultimate purpose of which will be to maintain the consistency of both the Administrative and Operational functions of the department. This Document which will be identified as Standard Operating Procedure # 2017- 001, will clearly define all of the documents that will be utilized by this department.

It will also provide for the formal process of how each document will be developed and adopted, implemented, and when necessary modified or replaced.

1) Administrative Procedures

Are documents that will provide mandatory guidance and direction to the members of the department. Said documents will pertain to the administrative functions of the department.

Examples:

- Membership application process
- Membership classification
- Disciplinary Policy
- Procedure and Guideline Development process

1.1) Adoption Process

At any time, an Executive or Line Officer may propose a needed Administrative Procedure. Said procedure will then go through a review process by the appropriate segment of the department (Line or Administrative)

- 1.1 Cont.) Once appropriately signed off, that document will be submitted to the Board of Fire Commissioners. Requesting their review and the adoption of a Formal Board Resolution, that will memorialize that document.
- 1.2) Once the Resolution has been passed. The appropriate Officer will be responsible to conduct a full review of the Administrative Procedure at the next regularly scheduled Department meeting. To include the intent, and all of the necessary Interpretations that will provide a clear understanding of the Documents purpose.
- Once the review in section 1.2 has been completed. That same officer will have the responsibility of posting the document on the department's WEB site, and also to place a hard copy at the department's Informational Center, for review and reference when necessary.
- 1.4) Amendment / Replacement Process:

Any modification / amendment to this document, will require the full development and review process as described in section 1.1. Once completed it will be submitted to the Board of Fire commissioners, requesting amendment of or the full replacement of the original document

2) Standard Operating Procedures

(Emergency Service Administrative Requirements)

These documents will provide for mandatory direction, pertaining to the emergency service operations that are provided by the Department.

These documents will be composed in an established format, derived and submitted as a proof document by any Line Officer. Once completed, a detailed review will be conducted by the Line Officers for impute. Once a satisfactory document has been completed, it will be signed off by the Chief Officers for implementation

Examples:

- Drivers Training / Certification
- Educational Path
- Turn out gear Issuance, Use, Care
- Apparatus Checks
- Once the review described above has been completed. The Chief or his designate will be responsible to provide a full and detailed review of the document at the next regularly scheduled Fire Department meeting. This review will provide the intent of the procedure, along with the necessary interpretations.
- Once the company review has been completed. The document will be posted at the Informational center and placed on the departments WEB site for review and reference when necessary.

2.3 Amendment and Replacement process:

Any modifications to this document will require that any proposed change and or all consideration/s are to be submitted to the Chief's Office for review. The review process as described in section 2.1 will be followed.

2.3 Cont. If the new changes are implemented, amending the original document. The Company review and posting procedures described in sections 2.1 and 2.2 of this document will be followed.

3) Standard Operating Guidelines

(Emergency Response)

These documents will be to provide specific guidance during **ALL**"Emergency Operations" conducted by the Department. Their content is to be strictly adhered too. However, it is also recognized that fire officers need to have a reasonable amount of flexibility. Allowing them to make sound decisions that would be based upon the situation / incident they would be confronted with.

These documents can be derived and submitted in "Proof form" to the Chief's Office by any line officer. Once submitted a detailed review of its content will be conducted by the entire line officer staff. Developing a suitable final operational document, that will be signed off by the Chief Officers.

Examples:

- Company Arrival Responsibilities
- Rescue Operations
- Response to Fumes calls
- Task Force Response
- 3.1 Once the final document has been signed off, the Chief or his designate will be responsible to provide a full and detailed review of that document at the next regularly scheduled fire department meeting. This review will provide the intent of the guideline, along with all if the necessary interpretations.

- Once the company review has been completed. The document will be posted on the fire departments WEB site and also at the fire departments informational center for review and reference when necessary.
- 3.3 Amendment and Replacement process:

Any Modifications to these documents will require that all proposed changes must be submitted to the Chief Office for review. The review process as described in section 2.1 will be followed.

If the new changes are implemented amending the original document. The Company review and posting process procedures described in section 2.1 and 2.2 of this document will be followed.

4) General Orders

Are documents that are designed to address an immediate / urgent operational need of the department, as identified by the Chief of Department. They will be derived and signed off by the Chief and will take effect IMMEDIATELY upon drafted and posted.

- 4.1 Upon issuance by the Chief, these documents will be transmitted to all members of the department via E-Mail ASAP. A hard Copy will also be posted at the informational center.
- 4.2 The document will be reviewed at the next regularly scheduled department meeting. The Chief or his designee will provide the purpose for its issuance, along with any and all interpretations necessary.

4.3 Amendment and Replacement process:

These documents will remain in effect until replaced by a more formal SOP/ SOG has been derived, and authorized directly by the Chief of department to replace this document.

Example:

To address an incident or improper operation, that would jeopardize the Safety of any member or the public. That would require immediate action/s to prevent another such occurrence.

To address any infraction, that would negatively affect the good name of the department. That would require immediate action, deemed necessary by the Chief of Department to reduce or eliminate any such exposure.

5) Fire Department By-Laws

A Document, that provides for the establishment of the Pine Hill Fire Department organization, and to provide for the general business operation of the organization. Establishing the Officers positions, their assigned responsibilities, how they are placed into or removed from office, the term of Office, the election process, meeting quorums, personnel conduct. It will also provide for the establishment of a ladies auxiliary and standing committees that are deemed necessary for the good operation of this fire department.

This document has been the corner stone of the organization, and was developed to ultimately establish the purpose of the organization, and how it is to operate in good order. It was created when the organization was formed, and has been modified several times over the years. All of which has been in an effort, to maintain pace with, and to address the ever changing needs and operations of the department. It was voted upon at a department meeting, and has obtained a majority vote of the membership present to approve it.

5.2 Amendments and Replacement process:

The Constitution and By-Laws can only be altered after proposed changes have been read at three consecutive meetings, regular or special, being discussed and voted on at the third meeting. Posting of changes at the fire station Informational center, at least two weeks in advance, of the date for the third reading of the change vote. A two thirds majority of the voting members present shall be required for the adoption of such changes.

6) IAFF Union Contract

- 6.1 This document is the work agreement negotiated and accepted by the Career Members of the Department and the Board of Fire Commissioners. Detailing the work period, compensation, benefits, grievance procedures, etc. of those employees. It is periodically negotiated between those parties with its duration established as a part of the negotiation process.
- 6.1 The condense of this agreement must be adhered too, but if it is felt that a segment of it has been violated. The Career personnel involved must follow the grievance procedures, that have been established within the signed contract.

6.3 Amendments and Replacement process

Amendments to this document can only be made during the negotiation process, as depicted in section 6.1. Secondly if a grievance has been filed that would require the opening of the contract and both parties agree it would be necessary to resolve the issues presented.

6.4 The most recently signed work agreement will remain in effect, until such time as a new agreement has been signed replacing the previous document.

CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1 COUNTY OF CAMDEN NEW JERSEY

I STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Cash Management Plan (the 'plan') has been prepared pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14 in order to set forth the basis for deposits ('deposits') and permitted investments ('investments') of certain public funds of the Pine Hill Fire District #1, pending the use of such funds for the intended purposes. The plan is intended to assure that all such public funds are deposited in interest bearing accounts or permitted investments. The intent of the Plan is to provide that the decisions made with regard to the Deposits and the Permitted Investments will be made in a manner intended to insure the safety and preservation of principal value, the liquidity (regarding its availability for the intended purpose) and the maximum investment return within such limits. The plan is intended to insure that any deposit or permitted investment matures within the time period that approximates the prospective need for the funds deposited or invested so that there is not a risk to the market value of such deposits or permitted investments.

II IDENTIFICATION OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS TO BE COVERED BY THE PLAN

The Plan is intended to cover the deposit and or investment of the following governmental fund types and accounts of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 as follows:

General Fund Special Revenue Fund Debt Service Fund Capital Projects Fund General Long-Term Debt Account Group

III DESIGNATION OF OFFICIALS OF THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1 AUTHORIZED TO MAKE DEPOSITS AND INVESTMENTS UNDER THE PLAN

The Fire District Administrator of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 shall be charged with the administering of this plan. The Fire District Administrator shall monitor all deposits and investments for consistency with this plan. No person shall engage in an investment transaction involving Pine Hill Fire District #1 funds except as directed or authorized by the Fire District Administrator. Prior to making such deposits or permitted investments, all authorized depositories or investment facilities shall be supplied with a written copy of this plan, which shall be acknowledged in writing by such parties and a copy of such acknowledgement shall be kept on file with the Fire District.

The Fire District Administrator shall be permitted to perform transfers of funds between accounts utilizing the internet services provided by the local bank.

VI AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS

- A. Except as otherwise specifically provided for herein, the Designated Officials are hereby authorized to invest the public funds covered by this Plan, to the extent not otherwise held in Deposits, in the following Permitted Investments:
 - (1) Bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America;
 - (2) Government money market mutual funds;
 - (3) Any obligation that a federal agency or a federal instrumentality has issued in accordance with an act of Congress, which security has a maturity date not greater than 397 days from the date of purchase, provided that such obligation bears a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or other external factor;

VI AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS (CONT'D)

- (4) Bonds or other obligations of the Local Unit or bonds or other obligations of school districts of which the Local Unit is a part or within which the schools district is located;
- (5) Bonds or other obligations, having a maturity date not more than 397 days from the date of purchase, approved by the Division of Investment of the Department of the Treasury for investment by Local Units;
- (6) Local government investment pools;

 - (d) the underlying securities are purchased through a public depository as defined in section 1 of P.L. 1970, c.236(C.17:9-41); and
 - (e) a master repurchase agreement providing for the custody and security of collateral is executed

For the purposes of the above language, the term "local government investment pool" shall have the following definitions:

- (b) which is rated in the highest category by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization;

- (c) which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of an eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-
- (d) 7 and repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities;
- (e) which is in compliance with rules adopted pursuant to the "Administrative" Procedure Act", P.L. 1968, c.410 (c52:14B-1 et seq.) by the Local Finance Board of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, which rules shall provide for disclosure and reporting requirements, and other provisions deemed necessary by the board to provide for the safety, liquidity and yield of the investments;
- (f) which does not permit investments in instruments that: are subject to high price volatility with changing market conditions; cannot reasonably be expected, at the time of interest rate adjustment, to have a market value that approximates their par value; or utilize an index that does not support a stable net asset value; and
- (g) which purchases and redeems investments directly from the issuer, government money market mutual fund, or the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund, or through the use of a national or State bank located within this State, or through a broker-dealer which, at the time of purchase or redemption, has been registered continuously for a period of at least two years pursuant to section 9 of P.I. 1967 c.9 (C.49:3-56) and has at least \$25 million in capital stock (or equivalent capitalization if not a corporation), surplus reserves for contingencies and undivided profits, or through a securities dealer who makes primary markets in U.S. Government securities and reports daily to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York its position in and borrowing on such U.S. Government securities.

VII SAFEKEEPING CUSTODY PAYMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF PLAN

To the extent that any Deposit or Permitted Investment involves a document or security which is not physically held by the Pine Hill Fire District #1, then such instrument or security shall be covered by a custodial agreement with an independent third party, which shall be a bank or financial institution, in the State of New Jersey. Such institution shall provide for the designation of such investments in the name of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 to assure that there is no

unauthorized use of the funds or the Permitted Investments or Deposits. Purchase of any method to insure that such Permitted Investments are either received by the

To assure that all parties with whom the Pine Hill Fire District #1 deals either by way of Deposits or Permitted Investments are aware of the authority and the limits set forth in this Plan, all such parties shall be supplied with a copy of this Plan in writing and all such parties shall acknowledge the receipt of that Plan in writing, a copy of which shall be on file with the fire department.

VIII REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Each month during which this Plan is in effect, the Fire District Administrator shall supply to the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 a written report of any Deposits or Permitted Investments made pursuant to this Plan, which shall include, at a minimum, the following information:

- A. The name of any institution holding funds of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 as a Deposit or a Permitted Investment.
- B. The amount of securities or Deposits purchased or sold during the immediately preceding month.
- C. The class or type of securities purchased or Deposits made.
- D. The book value of such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- E. The earned income on such Deposits or Permitted Investments. To the extent that such amounts are actually earned at maturity, this report shall provide an accrual of such earnings during the immediately preceding month.
- F. The fees incurred to undertake such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- G. The market value of all Deposits or Permitted Investments as of the end of the immediately preceding month.
- H. All other information which may be deemed reasonable from time to time by the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1.

IX TERM OF PLAN

This Plan shall be in effect from the date of this resolution to March 2, 2017. Attached to this Plan is a Resolution of the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 approving this Plan for such period of time. This Plan may be amended from time to time. To the extent that any amendment is adopted by the Commissioners, the Designated Officials are directed to supply copies of the amendments to all of the parties who otherwise have received the copy of the originally approved Plan, which amendment shall be acknowledged in writing in the same manner as the original Plan was so acknowledged.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1

THIS DOCUMENT constitutes a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. entered into this __//_ day of ______, 2017 between the County of Camden, a body of politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office at 520 Market Street, 14th Floor, Camden, New Jersey 08102 (the "County") and the Pine Hill Fire District #1, with its principal office at 1109 Erial Road, Pine Hill, New Jersey (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted August 21, 2008, the County of Camden authorized Shared Services Agreements between various municipalities to provide microfilming and records reorganization services that conform to NJDARM Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 72 adopted April 20, 2017, the County of Camden (Office of Archives & Records Management) authorized a Shared Services Agreement to provide the Pine Hill Fire District #1 access to the County-wide Records and Information Management (RIM) System and the Records Mine Software for records inventory and disposition management; and

WHEREAS, the District shall be responsible for providing access to all relevant records; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have approved the Shared Services Agreement by resolution in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq.; now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION of the promises and of the terms, covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. The District shall pay annual service fees directly to the software vendor for services provided under this agreement.
- 2. The District shall permit the County or its authorized representative to make visits to the site or sites where work is being provided for the purpose of assuring the progress of the project and/or appropriate use of the Records and Information Management (RIM) System and Records Mine Software.
- 3. The District will provide the vendors chosen by the County with access to all relevant information records.
- 4. The District shall defend, indemnify and save the County harmless from and against any and all claims of every nature and whatsoever kind, liabilities, damages, including damage to person or property, losses and judgments, and including cost and expenses incident thereto, arising from any act by, or negligence, intentional acts or omissions related to the use of the RIM system. The provisions of this paragraph shall survive the expiration or termination of this Shared Services Agreement, but only to the extent of matters and events occurring during the term of this Shared Services Agreement or any extension.
- 5. This Shared Services Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- 6. Any notices required, permitted, or contemplated under this Shared Services Agreement shall be in writing and forwarded to the addresses set forth on Page 1.
- 7. Neither party hereto may assign, either wholly or in part, any of its rights or obligations under this Shared Services Agreement.
- 8. In the event that a provision of this Shared Services Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

9. Neither party has any authority to enter into contracts or agreements on behalf of the other.

10. This Shared Services Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

11. This Shared Services Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, proposals or agreements, either written or oral. This Shared Services Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both parties.

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted August 21, 2008, the County of Camden authorized Shared Services Agreements between various municipalities to provide microfilming and records reorganization services that conform to NJDARM Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 72 adopted April 20, 2017, the County of Camden (Office of Archives & Records Management) authorized a Shared Services Agreement to provide the Pine Hill Fire District #1 access to the County-wide Records and Information Management (RIM) System and the Records Mine Software for records inventory and disposition management; and

WHEREAS, the District shall be responsible for providing access to all relevant records; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have approved the Shared Services Agreement by resolution in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq.; now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION of the promises and of the terms, covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. The District shall pay annual service fees directly to the software vendor for services provided under this agreement.
- 2. The District shall permit the County or its authorized representative to make visits to the site or sites where work is being provided for the purpose of assuring the progress of the project and/or appropriate use of the Records and Information Management (RIM) System and Records Mine Software.
- 3. The District will provide the vendors chosen by the County with access to all relevant information records.
- 4. The District shall defend, indemnify and save the County harmless from and against any and all claims of every nature and whatsoever kind, liabilities, damages, including damage to person or property, losses and judgments, and including cost and expenses incident thereto, arising from any act by, or negligence, intentional acts or omissions related to the use of the RIM system. The provisions of this paragraph shall survive the expiration or termination of this Shared Services Agreement, but only to the extent of matters and events occurring during the term of this Shared Services Agreement or any extension.
- 5. This Shared Services Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- 6. Any notices required, permitted, or contemplated under this Shared Services Agreement shall be in writing and forwarded to the addresses set forth on Page 1.
- 7. Neither party hereto may assign, either wholly or in part, any of its rights or obligations under this Shared Services Agreement.
- 8. In the event that a provision of this Shared Services Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

9. Neither party has any authority to enter into contracts or agreements on behalf of the other.

10. This Shared Services Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

11. This Shared Services Agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, proposals or agreements, either written or oral. This Shared Services Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both parties.
