### **POLICY**

Members of the public shall be permitted to examine or obtain copies of Pine Hill Fire District records in accordance with applicable law.

### **PROCEDURE**

- A. Requests for Records deemed to be public records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A *et seq*.
  - 1. Any person requesting to inspect public records or requesting to receive copies of them shall complete the form available from the District Administrator or his or her designee.
  - 2. Records shall be made available for review, copying, or electronic reproduction within timeframes established by the Open Public Records Act, based upon the time and resources necessary to recover the records.
  - 3. Where records are sought for review, District officials shall maintain appropriate security to insure that the records are maintained in their complete and original form.
  - 4. A person seeking copies or reproduction of public records shall be apprised by the District of the cost. The person making the request shall pay the full cost of copying or reproduction in advance of their preparation.
- B. Certain records are not deemed to be public records pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A et seq.

### Chief's Monthly Report

### November 2024

### Meetings:

- On Thursday evening the 7<sup>th</sup>, I attended the monthly commission meeting.
- On Tuesday morning the 8<sup>th</sup>, I had a meeting with Union President Kemery regarding (Chris Brown).
- On Friday morning the 15<sup>th</sup>, Battalion Chief Pizzo and I had a meeting with Firefighter Gordon Sr. to go over the repairs that are needed on the apparatus.
- On Wednesday evening the 27<sup>th</sup>, I attended a budget meeting with commissioners Harris & Waddington.

### **Calls for Service / Significant Concerns:**

- On Friday evening the 1<sup>st</sup>, Squad 6 responded to the area 802 Turnersville Road for a PED MVA (pedestrian motor vehicle accident). A male was found lying on the ground and the crew from the squad performed CPR on the male before he was pronounced.
- On Saturday evening the 2<sup>nd</sup>, Tower Ladder 6 was dispatched to 4 Edinburge Road in Blackwood for a reported house fire. Tower ladder 6 was ordered to set the main to the roof but they fell short because of improper placement of the engine company. The crew did assist with the extinguishment of the fire.
- On Monday morning the 4<sup>th</sup>, we were dispatched to Waterford Township for an Urban Interface Brush Fire Strike Team. I responded along with Engine 6 for structural protection. We were 1 of 5 engines that were dispatched and Engine 6 backed in the driveway of a property on Marcia Drive and stretched a handline to the rear of the property. We stood by for about 8 hours before being sent home.
- On Thursday morning the 7<sup>th</sup>, I responded along with Engine & Brush 6 to Lexington Drive in Voorhees for an Urban Interface Strike Team assignment. I operated as Lexington Drive Command, while the Engine & Brush were placed to do structural protection on Lexington Drive. I had 4 engines & 1 brush truck and protected 12 homes. A backfire was set around 15:30 and we operated on this fire for 10 hours.
- On Friday morning the 8<sup>th</sup>, we were dispatched to 113 Kirk Lane for a brush fire. I
  arrived first to find a large pile of clothing in the driveway on fire and fire spreading

- across the front yard. Crews were able to stop the fire from spreading into Pine Valley. We were able to view the homeowner's ring camera and determined that the fire started in the clothing and was a result of spontaneous combustion.
- On Tuesday evening the 12<sup>th</sup>, we were dispatched to 220 West Branch Ave apartment 1119 for an apartment fire. Engine 6 arrived first and reported smoke and fire showing with people jumping off the balconies. The lieutenant on Engine 6 requested "All Hands" and then the second alarm. Tower Ladder 6 & Quint 85 arrived and started searches and reported that we had someone trapped in unit 1114. That search was negative, and the majority of the residents had been accounted for. 5 police officers and 1 firefighter were sent to the hospital for smoke inhalation from the heavy smoke they encounter during the rescue efforts. There were a lot of missed orders from the incoming companies that contributed to the water issues we had and a lot of free Lansing that will be followed up with at the next Camden County Fire Chiefs meeting.
- On Sunday afternoon the 17<sup>th</sup>, we were dispatched to the 100 block of Country Club Road for a burn victim. I responded along with the engine found an adult female that was cooking chicken and spilled hot grease on both legs/top of her left foot. The patient had second degree burns and refused to be transported to the hospital. All notifications to the local, county and state fire marshals were made.

### Complaint:

 On Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup>, I received a voice message from Mrs. Walker who lives in the 1100 building of the Mansions Apartments. She claims that she had \$4500 dollars under her bed and during the fire she believes a firefighter stole it. I turned that voice mail message over to Pine Hill Police who stated they would investigate the complaint.

### Ambulance:

• While washing the ambulance and lifting the wiper blades, one blade fell off the metal arm and that arm hit the windshield causing it to crack. That windshield was replaced on Wednesday the 27<sup>th</sup>.

### **Public Relations:**

Nothing to report.

### **Tower Ladder:**

We received the one-year certification for the tower ladder.

### Squad:

On Wednesday the 27<sup>th</sup>, the squad went to Tactical to have the repairs to the light bar completed. This was covered under insurance and was caused by a tree that fell on the truck.

### SOP's/SOG's:

• We are still creating and renewing our policies.

### **Pump Testing:**

• On Saturday morning the 2<sup>nd</sup>, the pumps on all the trucks were completed and all passed.
