SPECIAL MEETING HELD TO INTRODUCE 2026 FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Waddington at 6:07 P.M. Chairman Waddington led the salute to the flag and read a statement regarding the Open Public Meetings Act.

NEW BUSINESS: Chairman Waddington said the purpose of the meeting was the introduction of 2026 budget, which raise revenues of \$1,765,856.19 which includes the amount to be raised by taxation of \$1,592,601.87.

Roll Call Vote: Commissioner Briggs – yes, Commissioner Hagarty – yes, Commissioner Harris – absent, Commissioner Wakeley – absent, Commissioner Waddington – yes. Motion passed with three yes votes.

CLOSE FLOOR TO THE PUBLIC: Chairman Waddington asked for a motion to close the floor to the public if there were no questions. There were none. A motion to close the floor to the public was made by Commissioner Hagarty and seconded by Commissioner Briggs. All were in favor. Motion passed.

Commissioner Hagarty provided thanks to Chief Hunter and Battalion Chief Pizzo for their extensive analysis and information with staffing scenarios. He said it demonstrated a tremendous amount of work and understanding. He thanked Captain Duvall for his involvement as well.
